

## QUEBEC GOLD—A NEW OPPORTUNITY

### Overview:

Savant has acquired a strategic land position on the prolific Cadillac Break in Quebec several kms west of the historic Malartic Mining Camp (proven & probable 8.7Mozs) and immediately adjacent to Osisko Mining's land holdings where it has permitted the development of its proposed open pit Canadian Malartic Mine Project (proven&probable reserves of 6.3Mozs). Savant's property is also located 10 km southeast and along strike from Agnico-Eagles' newly producing and richest gold mine, the Lapa Gold Mine (proven & probable reserves of 3.8Mt grading 8.8gpt).

The property, called Parbec covers 1.3 km of the vertical dipping Cadillac Break. The lithologies, structure and alteration associated with the known mineralization at Parbec are remarkably similar to those at the producing Lapa Mine located 10 km to the northwest. The Parbec property hosts a historic resource of 450,000 tonnes grading 4.6 gpt, which remains open to depth. (The historic resource is not NI43-101 compliant and should not be relied upon). Except in the immediately below the historic resource, the property has not been tested below a depth of 190 metres. Parbec provides a rare opportunity for discovery of a high-grade gold deposit similar to Agnico-Eagle's Lapa deposit.

### Parbec Property:

Savant announces an acquisition agreement (January 11, 2010) to acquire a 100% interest in the Parbec Property.

### Excellent Location and Characteristics:

- Over 20 Moz of past production and current reserves located within 15 km of the Parbec Property.
- Parbec covers 1.3 km of the Cadillac Break, host to the known gold deposits in the district
- Known mineralization on the property untested to depth
- Existing ramp access to the historic resource
- Parbec straddles a Provincial Highway and rail way with excellent access and low cost exploration
- Right to earn a 100% interest
- Located in the best mining jurisdiction in the world.

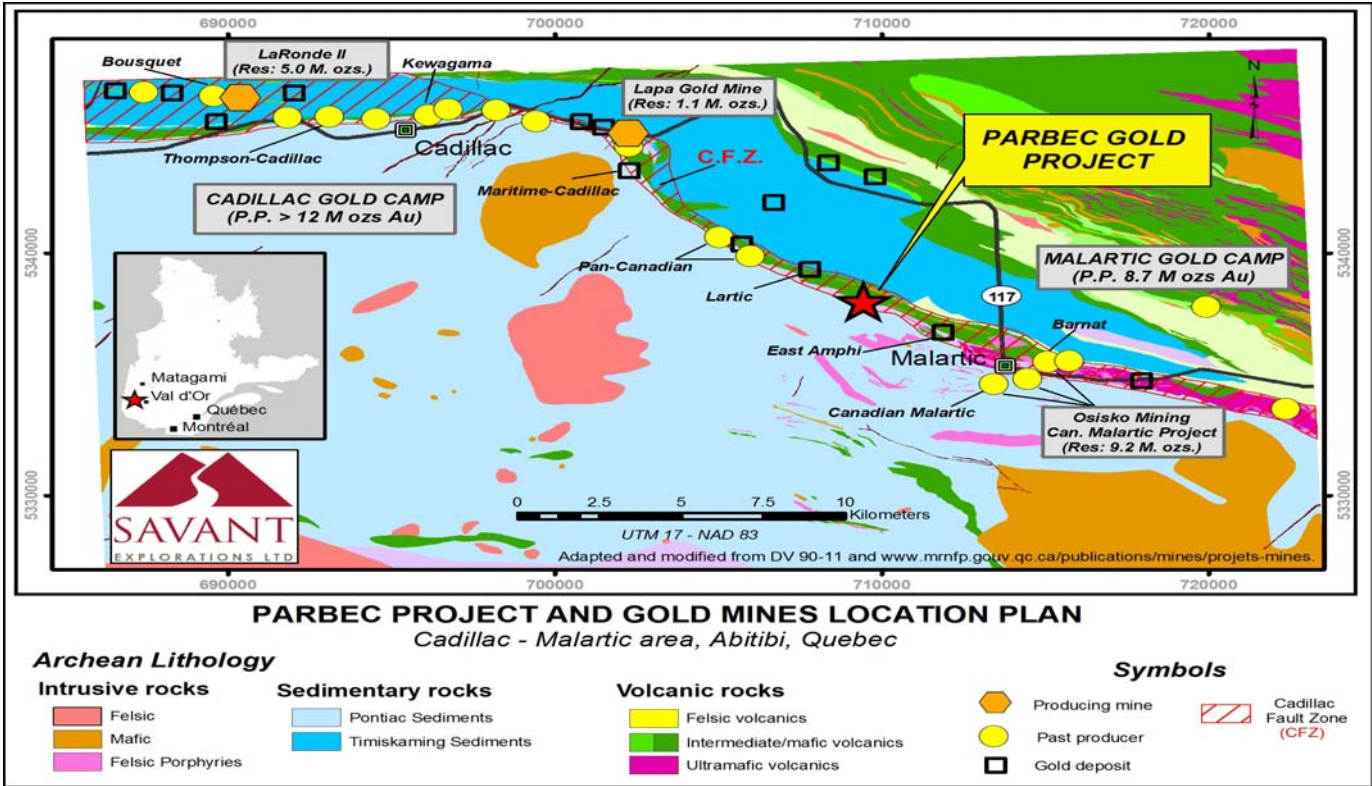


### Exploration Attractions:

- Historic Resource is open at depth. Most of the property untested below 190 metres.
- Alteration, known gold mineralization and lithologies on Parbec are very similar to that above Agnico-Eagles' Lapa Deposit.
- Ore bodies in the district have short strike lengths and long down plunge dimensions. Potential for discovery of 1 Mozs or more on the property.
- Low cost exploration

2010 PROGRAM

The potential to discover extensions to the known mineralization and new zones below 150 meters is very good. There is a 1.3 Km long strike length of favorable structural and lithological corridor. At Agnico-Eagles’ newly operating Lupa Mine and other known deposits in the district, ore zones have short strike lengths, but exceptionally long down plunge extensions of over 1 km length.

In 2010, Savant will test the down dip extensions of the known alteration and mineralization at 200m centering down to the 400m level. The program would entail 3500m of drilling.
